**Subject: Regarding Awareness to Students about Unfair Mean Cases and Impersonation
Cases in the Examination.**

It has been observed that most of the students entering in the Diploma Examination are not completely aware of the consequences of Unfair Mean Cases & Impersonation cases in the Examination. The reason behind this may be that most of the students are simply coming from schools and may not be aware of the sanctity & integrity of the SBTE, Haryana Examination System. Secondly, some of the student may be misguided by some bad social element also.

To make aware these students especially coming from rural background, schools and all others it is intimated that Principals/ HOD's/ Councilors and specially class tutors should inform in the classes at least six times during each semester from time to time. They should make

them understood the punishment, consequences and other problems through examples of previous candidates who are facing the UMC cases. Every tutor should announce regarding this important information during the session, before the preparatory holidays and start of the semester positively. **Candidates must be awakened through notices also, which must be displayed on the notice board of the Institutions, in hostels, corridors and at all the other important student activities centers to make them well aware of the consequences of this menace.** By this awareness & information the students must understand that hard work and logical study is only the alternative to succeed in the examination in the SBTE Haryana. So it is suggested that every student of the State should work hard to clear the examination and to acquire the knowledge, which is requirement of time for placement purposes also.

As sky is the limit of improvement & there is always scope of improvement and Deptt. Of Technical Education, Haryana is trying to make the examination system excellent, so every Institution should contribute in the scheme by fostering it masterfully. **It is also suggested and requested that after creating this awareness among the students, Principals/ Institutions must write to this office so that its effects may be monitored/ measured and some further action may be taken in this era in the coming examinations.**

During the UMC meeting and appellate Committee, it has been observed by the statement of students that in some cases, the UMC material is already found in the desk or nearby the candidate, due to non-cleanliness of the rooms and sitting arrangement. The Suptd. exam must ensure in both the half's i.e. morning as well as evening shift that cleaning of sitting benches/arrangement and rooms must be done properly and no discriminated material remains.
